This has been Newf Friends busiest year with 36 Newfs surrendered to us as of mid-November. Many of the newfs in our program had serious health issues and required extensive veterinary care and long term foster care. Some of the Newfs who had the most desperate needs include:

- Penelope - bilateral cherry eye
- Jade - torn cruciate ligament
- Geordie - torn cruciate ligament
- Ace - extensive skin issues
- Ty - extensive skin issues
- River - bilateral torn cruciate ligaments (pictured here with Dr. Facey and staff)
